Sunday Meeting for Worship



How do I get to the Quaker Centre ?

You will see from the map below that there are 4 metro stations within 5 minutes walk.



How to enter the Centre ?

The Centre is hidden in an alley, the entry to this is behind large green double doors...Which is a pity as it is not just a matter of pushing the door open!

There are 2 ways of getting in to the Centre (See the following photo)

Firstly by **114Bis**, the green double doors, which has a digicode on the right-hand side. You can call **01 45 48 74 23** from you mobile (cell phone) so we can open for you. That is the easier way and once through the doors, go down the steps on your right.

Secondly you can enter by **114**, the main entrance to the building. Use the electronic directory on the right of the door and search for “Centre Quaker” and then ring the bell. Once open, go to into the entrance hall and towards the back there is an a staircase to the right (NB the light for the staircase is down a few steps!). Go to the basement.



Accès pour les visiteurs a mobilité réduite

Par le 114bis (porte cochère) l'accès au centre emprunte un escalier extérieur.

Access for handicapped visitors

Via the entrance at 114, there is a lift to the basement. Unfortunately, there are still 4 steps to ascend and the lift is too small to accommodate a wheelchair.

Via the entrance at 114bis, there is a steep external staircase to descend.
